

**PETER MOLNAR UNDETERRED BY HIS FAILURE TO WIN A WORLD TITLE
IN THE 3RD WBPf WORLD CHAMPIONSHIP IN MALACCA THE PREVIOUS WEEK TURNED THE
TABLE TO CAPTURE THE COVETED 1ST WBPf PRO-AM TITLE IN SINGAPORE**

Peter was 3rd runner-up in the 100 kg Heavy Weight Class in the 3rd WBPf World Men's Bodybuilding Championship held in Malacca, Malaysia from 9 - 14 November 2011. He lost to champion Wong Hong of Malaysia and to two other competitors from Iran and Ukraine.

Peter was determined to capture the coveted 1st ever WBPf Pro-Am Classic crown in Singapore to make up for his failure to win a World title in Malacca. He travelled by bus from Malacca, Malaysia after the 3rd WBPf Men's World Bodybuilding Championships to compete in the 1st WBPf Pro-Am Classic which took place on 16th November at Powerhouse, St. James Power Station.

He was disciplined and kept to a strict diet and appeared on stage with a well chiseled physique which allowed him to display his superb symmetry and proportion to vow the judges and audience in all three rounds of judging.

Peter was the crowd favorite and defeated the other 14 top athletes with the judges unanimous decision to win the 1st WBPf Pro -Am Classic title and USD5,000 cash prize money.

Peter, after winning the title quoted: "I SHALL RETURN NEXT YEAR TO DEFEND MY CROWN IN THE WBPF PRO-AM CLASSIC IN SINGAPORE. I LOVE SINGAPORE."
